

Preparing your computer for broadband



Internet Explorer

1. Go to Tools > Internet Options.
2. On the "Connections" tab, select "Never dial a connection".
3. Click LAN Settings to open a new window with the LAN settings. Check "Automatically detect settings" and click OK.
4. Click OK.
5. Close Internet Explorer. The settings will take effect when you start it up again.



Mozilla Firefox

1. Go to Tools > Options.
2. In the "Advanced" section, select the "Network" tab.
3. Click "Settings" (Configure how Firefox connects to the internet).
4. Make sure "No proxy" is selected and click OK.
5. Click OK, and then OK.
6. Close Firefox. The settings will take effect when you start it up again.



Opera

- Opera should detect your connection settings automatically, unless you connect through a proxy server.
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Outlook Express (comes with Windows)

1. Open your email account settings. Go to Tools > Accounts..., and click "Properties" with your account selected.
2. On the "Connection" tab, deselect "Always connect to this account using:"
3. Click "OK", then "Close".



Microsoft Outlook (part of Microsoft Office)

1. Open your email account settings. Go to Tools > E-mail Accounts, select "View or change existing e-mail accounts", click "Change" with your email account selected and then click "More Settings ...".
2. On the "Connection" tab, make sure "Connect using my Local Area Network (LAN)" is selected, and depending on whether you have a modem or not, you can check "Connect via modem when Outlook is offline".
3. Click "OK", "Next", and "Finish".
